

Residential Connections

The Residential Connections Program is for customers with high security water entitlements (WE's) who require water for use on an area up to 1 Ha. This new supply option will enable us to deliver eligible customers their water in the best way possible, at the fairest price.

We have introduced this product as part of our unmetered upgrade program, with all Murrumbidgee Irrigation (MI) outlets required to be either metered or supplied through a restricted connection by February 2025, under the Off-farm Efficiency Program.

What are my supply options?

- Upgrade to a Residential Connection (unmetered restricted supply), with the size based on WE holdings, or
- An option for properties greater than 1 Ha, to upgrade to a low flow outlet (metered)

What are the benefits of a Residential Connection?

- Simple and efficient water supply
- Significant savings: reduction in connection costs and annual charges compared to low flow outlets
- Greater flexibility: the water entitlement above deemed usage it is not tied to your connection. You are free to do with this as you choose.

Who is eligible to use this product?

This product is predominantly for domestic and/or garden water usage, and only for customers with High Security water entitlements.

Customers with no water entitlements will need to use our Garden Licence product, or purchase water entitlements.

How will this work?

Designs include options for both 2ML and 4ML of WE holdings. These sizes are typically suited for:

- 0.5 Ha for a Small RC (2ML) 40mm suction pipe/32mm discharge pipe, and
- 1 Ha for a Large RC (4ML) 50mm suction pipe/40mm discharge pipe

Residential Connection customers are required to supply their own pipe and pump to access water through the MI-installed access point. All other infrastructure changes are made at MI's cost.
